PARKING AND PICK-UP ON CONFERENCE DAYS

1. 12:15 to 12:25: Depot pick-up. Please pick up students who are not eating lunch at school.
2. 12:30 to 1:00: All driveway spots and yellow curb in front of the school are **3 minute parking**, just long enough for you to walk up to collect your child and leave.
3. 1:00 to 5:30: All driveway spots are available for parking. The best parking options will be the community center and up the hill on Union Street.
4. Planning, patience, and allowing extra time are key to making school parking work effectively. Thank you for your cooperation and support.

AFTER SCHOOL ON CONFERENCE DAYS

After school care charges start at 12:45. After school is very crowded on conference days; it really helps if you are able to pick up your child before 1:00. At 1:00 students have silent reading and stories. If you return with your child for a conference, please check your child into after school; there is no charge for this service while you are in conference. After school cannot accommodate younger siblings who are not elementary school age.
